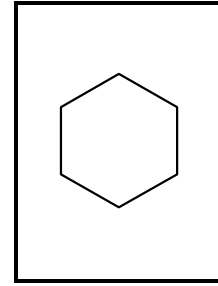
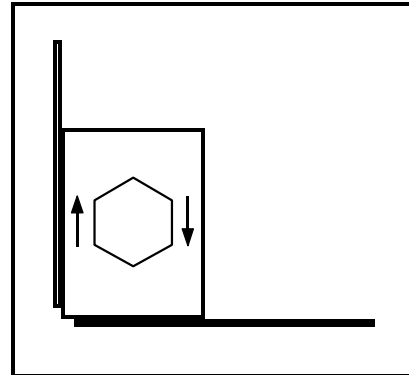


6-Sided Mats

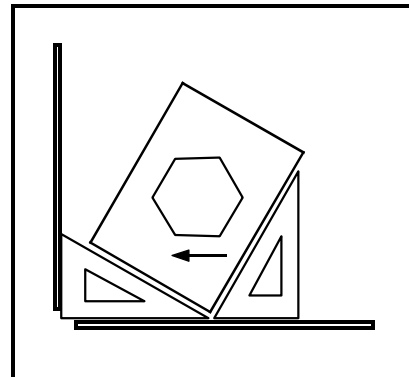
- 1) Draw the mat opening in pencil on the back of the mat.



- 2) Place the mat in the corner against the guides and close the hold down.
- 3) Set the stops for the left and right cuts using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 4) Make the right and left cuts. If cutting a double or inlayed mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.



- 5) Place the mat at 30 degrees to the right using the 30/60 triangles. Hold in place with the bottom hold down.
- 6) Set the stops for the bottom cut using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 7) Make the cut, then turn the mat end for end and make the opposite cut. If cutting a double or inlayed mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.



- 8) Place the mat at 30 degrees to the left using the 30/60 triangles. Hold in place with the bottom hold down.
- 9) Set the stops for the bottom cut using the guide marks on the pressure foot.
- 10) Make the cut, then turn the mat end for end and make the opposite cut. If cutting a double or inlayed mat, insert the stop spacers and make these cuts in the second color.
